#### **BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

A special meeting of the Board of Directors of the Gallatin Gateway County Water & Sewer District was held at the Gallatin Gateway Community Center (moved due to the unavailability of the Fire Station), Gallatin Gateway, MT, on August 6, 2015. Present at the meeting were board members Eric Amend, Ted Border, Ashley Kroon and David Sullivan. Director Merle Adams was absent. General Manager Matt Donnelly and Secretary Maralee Parsons Sullivan were also present. There were no members of the public in attendance.

President Border called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Secretary Maralee Parsons Sullivan recorded the minutes of the meeting.

<u>Discussion and Decision on Engineer Amendment 6a to Review and Amend the PER for the District's Wastewater treatment and collection project</u>

President Border advised that he had signed the USDA (RD) Letter of Conditions and the accompanying paperwork to complete the SEARCH grant. RD is providing a total of \$30,000 in this grant. RD has sent the paperwork to Washington DC to complete the process. In light of the grant approval, the Board proceeded to discuss the approval of the engineer's amendment 6 (aka 6a) for \$17,800, to complete the work to amend the District's PER. Director Amend made the motion to approve engineer's amendment 6 (aka 6a); Director Sullivan seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
